GRANNY CHING'S SIMPLE TIPS FOR PARENTS

It's time to toilet train my child! Where do I begin?????

First of all parents, you have to make toilet training as natural and non-threatening as possible. Keep a relaxed and positive attitude.

1. Start with going to the bathroom before bedtime. Wait with your child if you have to. And when he/she does pee - praise him/her for the success.
2. Regularly bring your child to the bathroom as soon as he/she wakes up. That way, he/she develops the habit.
3. Let your child do the flushing as well if they want to, it can be fascinating for them to watch the water swirl down. If they don't want to - it's fine. Don't rush to flush - they'll get there.
4. Continue with diapers for the first week and observe or ask teachers, other grown-ups taking care of the child to observe if she still needs them or not. Then again praise your child for not needing the nappy anymore!
5. Encourage your child to wear underwear without the nappies and make them feel proud that they've done away with it.

***** Always handle failed attempts or little accidents calmly and kindly.**

Sometimes, toilet training can be as quick as one week but sometimes it can take as long as a month or two - don't stress about this parents just be consistent!
